


Changing Default Programs

Windows gives the ability to control what program will open a particular file type, if you have multiple programs that could open it. To change the program that opens a file, perform the following. We will use a PDF document as our example, and these settings are from Windows 8, so your machine may look different, but the steps will be very similar.

- From your Start screen, search for “file type.” You will need to sort by “Settings” (1). Click on the option “Make a file type always open in a specific program” (2).



- In the list that appears, locate “.pdf” and select it. Press the “Change Program” button on the right side of the screen.



- In the list that appears, select the program you wish to be the new default. You may need to use the drop-down to view more options.
